From the Pastor: Virginia Gerbrandt Richert

This year our theme for Lent is: **Seeking God's Ways**. This theme will push us each week to look at some of the truths about the ways of God, as well as the many ways that God's people can get it wrong. We will look at the ways we sometimes think God is offering us one thing (like privilege) but what God is really offering looks quite different (like inclusion). Or how we might think the world works in one way (scarcity), but really it works in a very different way (abundance), and how we think power means one thing (control), but it is really found in something else (solidarity).

Each week we will have a physical representation of the ways that we attempt to put God in a box of our own making, of our own assumptions, and how we need to release the human made boundaries on God to make space to seek and see God's ways. It is only then, by releasing these constraints, that we will be able to fully embrace God's ways. The weekly themes are:

- From security to generosity
- From fear to compassion
- From earning to receiving
- From estrangement to embrace
- From scarcity to abundance
- From power over to power with
- From ending to possibility

It is our hope that as we explore this theme of "seeking God's ways" that we will find the encouragement we need to explore the ways we are being called to step outside of our own limitations to acts of greater faithfulness and love.
