FROM the PASTOR: Mark Tiessen-Dyck

In the spring, Kelsey Driedger and Seth Klassen began meeting with Josh and myself for a baptism preparation journey. Sometimes meeting in person and sometimes by zoom, we explored the biblical story, studied Christian convictions, discussed what it means to follow Jesus, reflected on the history of the church, and delved into myriad questions and dimensions of our faith. Hilda Franz and Lyndon Toews joined our meetings as mentors, contributed to our discussions, and have been valuable partners for Kelsey and Seth in the journey.

Throughout this experience, Josh and I have witnessed God's work in the lives of Kelsey and Seth and their growth in response. Kelsey and Seth have accepted Christ's call to baptism and for this we rejoice! Initially, we had insisted that the baptism would occur when we are able to worship in person, however, with the uncertainty of these times, together we have discerned that we will move forward with the baptism under the current circumstances. When the path forward is clear, it is unnecessary, even painful, to wait. We are planning for Seth and Kelsey to be baptised on February 14! The worship service will be live streamed (not pre-recorded as has been our practice). We are asking that everyone join as a congregation on February 14, at 10:30am to join in worship and celebration on this essential day in the life of our church.

We are planning boldly and lightly for this day, recognizing both its importance and that we live in a time when there are many disruptions due to people becoming ill or requiring to isolate. There may also be changes in what are safe gatherings and interactions. Should circumstances require an adjustment in our plans we will respond trusting that God is still at work.

I encourage you to pray for Kelsey and Seth. We are grateful to God for their saying 'yes' to baptism and ask God's continued leading in their lives of faithfulness.
