This Lent, the book of Jeremiah will be our guide as we journey to exile and home, to cross and resurrection.

Exile and homecoming is not only the Israelite's journey but ours. Wandering far off from the intimacy of the garden, we live in exile searching for purpose and home in the Kingdom of God. Throughout Lent, it is our hope that our worship times will guide us in exploring how we are distant from God, how God continues to speak to us in exile, and how God invites us into new covenant in the death and resurrection of Jesus.
