

## **LOVE EXERCISE #1**

**Create 'stumbling stones' of God's love:** place post-it notes that say things like "You are loved," or "God loves you" around your home or office where you will "stumble over" them. Or set an alarm to beep every hour. Each time it goes off or you stumble over a note, pause for 5-seconds to take a deep breath and say to yourself: "I will breathe out the tensions within and I will breathe in God's love," or simply "I am loved by God."
