FROM THE PASTOR: Virginia Gerbrandt Richert

Some of you might be aware that we have a bursary program with **Recovery of Hope**. This means that ABC is listed as a part of their CARE program. The CARE program covers the cost of counselling for individuals, couples, and families for up to 6 sessions per year. This is a completely confidential program. No names or addresses are included.

I, myself, benefited from this program several years ago, and I was surprised how easy it was to access. I simply called Recovery of Hope to make an appointment, and at the first appointment I filled out the required form, and then they sent the invoice to ABC. I went on to attend 3 or 4 counselling sessions under that program. It was nice to not have to think about or consider the cost of these sessions when I was making the appointment.

Meeting with a counsellor is something that I have engaged in on several occasions throughout my life. They have given me a place to talk about and process my feelings, without hurting anyone else's feelings, and without committing to always thinking one way. They have encouraged me in areas that I wanted to grow and helped me find the tools or resources I needed. I have valued these meetings because they gave me an outside perspective on my life as well as a companion for the journey.

Sometimes I was able to eventually tell others the things I shared with my counsellor, sometimes not. But in either case being able to talk through the issues with the counsellor was always helpful.
