FROM THE PASTOR: Virginia Gerbrandt Richert

Did you know that this week we began a bible study discussion group at church? That doesn't sound like anything too radical. We are a church after all. We are called to read our Bibles and study them. But I was surprised to learn how few people have participated in an actual discussion based bible study before. The only Bible studies that I can remember participating in were a few with my high school youth group or ones that I have led, and they were always isolated, one off events.

This caused me to wonder, how many of you have ever participated in a Bible study discussion group? And if so, how long ago was that? How many of us are actively reading and discussing our Bibles with one another in a deliberate way?

Our Bible study is based on material created for the Anabaptism at 500 Study Bible that is being created, which means it is deeply rooted in the Anabaptist tradition. The Anabaptists believe that the Bible is to be read and interpreted within the community. And that all believers, through the Holy Spirit, are capable of doing this.

So, I wonder, how can we as a church or as leaders encourage or facilitate more Bible study discussions? Is this something you might be interested in? or how is this already happening? I would love to hear your thoughts on this.
