Guerillas of Grace: Prayer for the Battle – By Ted Loder

I admire this prayer for its brutal honesty. How many of us, like Ted Loder, struggle with remaining focused on God, even in times we have specially dedicated for the purpose of prayer? My own mind whirls ahead to the coming events of the week or fly's backwards to review what has been said and done. Worries, excitements, ideas, and a host of other emotions and thoughts tear my attention away from God and place it back firmly on myself.

A spiritual guide once talked about what to do in times of distraction. Take the thought that has caused your attention to wander, hold it in your mind, name it as important, and then either imagine laying it aside to refocus attention on God, or bring it to God in prayer.

For me, this helps. But it is not a cure all. The struggle remains.

I remember being shocked at some point in my late teen years that adults did not have prayer all figured out. Growing up, I don't ever remember hearing anything like Ted's honesty in the prayer above. However, it's possible my mind had wandered. • Ted's words show honesty to God, honesty to himself, and honesty to others.

Young people today value in their elder's authenticity over answers. Perhaps, in a similar way, honesty is more important for our faith and the faith of the community than pretending to have it all figured out. Can we speak this prayer and embrace honesty to God, to ourselves, and to our community?

CHURCH ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Children's bulletins are back for the summer!
