FROM THE PASTOR - Mark Tiessen-Dyck

When the idea of doing foot washing was presented, I was convinced that it could be a profound experience for our church. Our music and worship committee, together with Virginia, are planning a Good Friday service that will include communion and foot washing. I have participated in foot washing in the past and witnessed its significance as a sign of our commitment to serve each other as Christ served us. Even though foot washing is not part of our tradition as it is in some churches, in recent years we have been enriched as a community when we've tried new things and stretched ourselves. The Holy Spirit has guided us to growth.

While we will have hand washing as an alternative (particularly for people who may face some physical challenges with removing footwear, kneeling etc...), I encourage everyone who is able to prepare yourself to participate in foot washing. This could mean overcoming worry about how our feet look, our fear of vulnerability, or overcoming the 'ick' factor. All ages will be invited to participate. You are welcome to talk to one of the pastors if you have questions.

It's impossible to overstate how astonishing and confounding it was when Jesus took a towel, knelt, and washed his disciple's feet (John 13). This was the job of a servant or slave. Recognizing this, Peter protested, "No. You will never wash my feet!" He then misconstrued what Jesus was doing as an act of purification not an act of loving service; "Lord, not only my feet but also my hands and my head!"

Jesus replied, "Unless I wash you, you won't have a place with me," and, "I have given you an example: Just as I have done you also must do."
