

After Easter we are going to begin another new practice in our worship services. As pastors, we have discussed this several times since last fall and have discerned that it is time to give it a try.

We will be inviting people from the church to be interviewed by one of the pastors. These interviews will be a few minutes as part of our worship service and will explore a person's volunteer role in the church or community, how someone lives out their faith through their work, or an experience or opportunity that someone has had.

Our hope is that these interviews give us an opportunity to get to know people from the church, learn about how others are serving God and living their faith, foster inspiration and creativity among us, and help us see how God is at work in our church and community.
