So, I have been trying to brain storm other ways to build and support relationships in our personal lives, as well as in the life of the church. For it is through relationships that we are able to support, encourage and challenge one another to grow in our faith and walk with God.

One idea that I have had is old fashioned letter writing and cards. Not just emails and texts but pen and paper writing. I am going to see if slowing down, and reaching out is able to build bridges of connection and support. Join me if you want and see what comes.
