FROM the PASTOR - Mark Tiessen-Dyck

Our Advent and Christmas sermon series this year will be an introduction to Jesus we're calling "Jesus, nice to meet you".

I've felt that too often as preachers we assume previous knowledge or understanding when we preach. We use language or concepts that are only accessible if you are already familiar with the biblical story or always been part of the church. As pastors, we are challenging ourselves in this series to preach also for people who may have no familiarity with the story of Jesus. What do we need to know about Jesus if we are meeting him for the first time? For people who have known Jesus for a long time and studied the scriptures, returning to the basics from time to time is important as well.

If you have family or friends who have expressed interest about faith, spirituality, the church, or Jesus himself, this would be a great time to invite them to participate in our worship services and learn more about Jesus.
