From the Pastor: Josh Janzen

"Happy are people who make peace, because they will be called God's children." Matthew 5:9 [CEB]

As we celebrate Peace Sunday this week, I wanted to reflect on the Beatitude that has called us to make peace. We might often think of making peace as simply ending conflicts. But the Greek word for peace, Eirene, and its Hebrew counterpart, Shalom, offer something vastly different. These words for God's peace offer visions of whole and healed relationships: between us and God, between us and the other, between us and the entirety of creation. True peace, God's peace, isn't just the absence of violence or conflict. Rather, the peace Jesus has called us to make is a peace that seeks for relationships to flourish and thrive. True peace is attentive to our relationship with God, loves our neighbor, and actively seeks justice for the widow, the orphan, the alien, and the oppressed. Peace then isn't just about making nice with each other and smoothing over the conflicts that come up. Peace is joining in on what God is already doing in this world, that God's kingdom come, and that God's will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. As we live in this season of uncertainty and anxiety, let us be makers of God's peace.
